G-Star Announces The Krane Academy for Motion Pictures

The Founder of The Krane Academy is Master Producer Jonathan D. Krane. Mr. Krane, a Yale Law School graduate with a Doctor of Jurisprudence, has produced 43 films that have grossed over two billion dollars at the box office. His feature films include *Swordfish*, *Face Off*, *The General's Daughter* and all of the *Look Who's Talking* movies (the first of which is the highest grossing and most profitable comedy in film history). He has owned his own Hollywood Studio with over 500 employees in several countries and was the Co-founder and CEO of Blake Edwards Entertainment where he produced two *Pink Panther* movies. He discovered Kim Basinger, gave Bruce Willis his first feature film role (*Blind Date*), and managed Drew Barrymore, Ellen Degeneres, Julie Andrews, Kirsty Ally, John Travolta, David Caruso, Ashton Kutcher, and Pierce Bronson as well as 150 Stars and Directors.

Mr. Krane will personally teach the course based on his definitive book on the motion picture industry, "*A Revolutionary Approach to the Art and Science of Moviemaking: A Treatise on Fixing the Accidental Industry*". Mr. Krane will train Producers to know everything about producing films, from finding or creating the idea, to developing the script, packaging the director and stars, financing the film and all aspects of physical production. Each student will then actually begin their careers in the film industry profession while making a feature film with Mr. Krane. Mr. Krane will be producing all of his future films in Palm Beach County.
