## School-wide Progress Monitoring Plan

State law requires a Progress Monitoring Plan (PMP) when a student is functioning below grade level and is not on track for promotion. Refer to the *Student Progression Plan* for the desired student performance level for grades K-2. The desired level of performance for grades 3-12 for reading, math, and science is level 3; for writing it is a minimum score of 8 (3-3-2).
